

## **PRIVACY & SECURITY POLICY**

### **1. PRIVACY POLICY**

- 1.1. Any information which you provide to Pelican Systems PTY, whether on any forms you complete or through this web site, and any information which Pelican Systems PTY have about you will be regarded by Pelican Systems PTY as personal information and, subject to the Terms and Conditions, be treated as confidential.
- 1.2. No personal information will be disclosed to third parties without the user's permission; however, Pelican Systems PTY may share personal information with business partners.
- 1.3. Pelican Systems PTY gathers and will be in possession of the following private and personal information of users:
  - 1.3.1. Information provided by the user voluntarily
  - 1.3.2. Information automatically provided (e.g. cookies) - this information is gathered to improve the efficiency of your browsing on the Pelican Systems PTY web site. Cookies are harmless to computer and do not carry viruses.
- 1.4. By using this web site the user consents to the following:
